EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description:** Severely purulent exudate in and around eyes and nose
- **Duration:** Unknown
- **Cause:** Viral disease
- **Prognosis** – In this case, severely poor - grave
- **Recommendation:** Humane euthanasia

COMMENTS

The animal presented to us was in a severely bad state and already affected by this condition for some time. Both eyes were affected as well as the nose were full of purulent material.

There was signs of dehydration and emaciation, but not to an extent that it will cause the collapse of the animal at this point.

In my opinion this animal: - suffered unnecessarily for a period of time, to a point where treatment would be very difficult with poor results and therefor it was decided in the best interest of the animal, to be humanely euthanised.
