Mentation: BAR, friendly dog
 Thoracic auscultation: Heart and lung sounds normal
 Abdominal palpation: Abdomen is relaxed. Abdomen feels empty
 Lymph nodes: No lymph node enlargement
 Rectal exam: Anal glands empty, normal colour stool on thermometer tip
 Oral exam: No abnormalities
 Ear exam: Normal

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Orthopedic exam: Patient resists extension of right shoulder. No other joint or bone discomfort found

Other:

Severely underweight with protruding ribs, spinous processes and scapular spines

Hairloss bilaterally behind ears

Fur is dull, brittle and matted

Patient has fleas

L iris has patches of darker pigmentation laterally and medially. R eye is uniformly blue

Anaemic

Bloodsmear:

No blood parasites seen

Blood platelets appear normal in number

No increased activity of white blood cells

Suspect anaemia is due to a high flea and worm burden

Plans

Patient needs to be fed to increase body condition

Advise flea treatment and dewormer
