



REPORT

INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY: INSP. CARINA BODENSTEIN AND INSP. LWAZI NTUNGELE

DATE: 18 AUGUST 2023

TIME: 13H00 – 15H30

FINDINGS:

UPON OUR ARRIVAL THE GATE APPEARED TO BE CLOSED. I CALLED THE TELEPHONE NUMBER I COULD FIND ON GOOGLE (0826160996). A MAN WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS PIERRE STEYL (PROPERTY OWNER) ANSWERED THE PHONE. I INTRODUCED MYSELF AND INFORMED HIM WE ARE AT THE PROPERTY TO CONDUCT AN INSPECTION. HE INFORMED ME THAT I CAN'T CONDUCT AN INSPECTION AS THEY HAVE THEIR OWN INSPECTORATE WITH INSPECTORS, I ADVISED HIM THAT WE HAVE RECEIVED A COMPLAINT AND THAT WE HAVE TO INVESTIGATE THE COMPLAINT. HE REPLIED THAT HE WILL CALL HIS INSPECTOR (SUZANNE MOSTERT) TO MEET US AT THE GATE.

WE WAITED APPROXIMATELY 10 MINUTES THEN THE LADY IDENTIFIED AS SUZANNE MOSTERT ("MOSTERT") ARRIVED AT THE GATE. MOSTERT WAS ACCOMPANIED BY AN UNIDENTIFIED COLOURED ADULT FEMALE.

I INTRODUCED MYSELF AND INSP NTUNGELE AND ADVISED MOSTERT ABOUT THE COMPLAINT RECEIVED. MOSTERT OPENED THE GATE FOR US AND ACCOMPANIED US TO THE FEED ROOM.

WE OBSERVED:

+/- 15 BALES OF OAT HAY

+/- 5 BALES LUCERN

+/-20 BALES OF STRAW (USED FOR BEDDING)

THERE WERE BINS WITH A SELF-MIX CONCENTRATE (TEFF, LUCERN AND 10% EQUI-FEEDS)

THE FOOD OBSERVED APPEARED TO BE ENOUGH FOR THE NUMBER OF HORSES CURRENTLY IN THEIR CARE.

FOOD IS COLLECTED ON A WEEKLY BASIS FROM EQUI-FEEDS.

THE HORSE GRAZE THE ENTIRE DAY (FROM 09H00 – 16H00) WHERE THERE IS SUFFICIENT GRAZING IN THE CAMPS.

WE FURTHER OBSERVED THE STABLES AND THE ENTIRE AREA WHERE THE HORSES ROAM AND KEPT – **REFER TO THE CHECKLIST ATTACHED FOR FULL PARTICULARS OF THIS INSPECTIONS**

THEY ARE A SANCTUARY BUT ADOPT OUT THEIR ANIMALS - THEY HAVE AN ENTIRE ADOPTION PROGRAM WHERE THE ADOPTEE HAS TO COMPLETE AN ADOPTION CONTRACT, HOME INSPECTIONS ARE DONE AND THE ANIMALS ARE STERILISED

THE LAYOUT OF THE FARM IS AS FOLLOWS:





THE ENTIRE FARM IS APPROXIMATELY 20 HA. THE MAJORITY OF THE FARM IS ALLOCATED FOR GRAZING WITH THE BOTTOM SECTION (4 HA) ALLOCATED FOR WINYARDS (ADDITIONAL MONTHLY INCOME).

PROPERTY PURPOSE:

THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THE YARD IS FOR THE RESCUED ANIMALS AND SOME OF THE HORSES ARE LIVERY HORSES.

THERE ARE NO SPESIFIC BREEDS OF HORSES, THEY ARE ALL MIX BREEDS, WITH THE ONE EXEPTION OF BEING A FRIESHIAN.

HEALTH MANAGEMENT:

EACH ANIMAL HAS A FILE WITH RELEVANT DETAILS LIKE AREA FOUND, CONFISCATED FROM, MEDICAL HISTORY AND TREATMENT PROVIDED.

EVERY NEW ANIMAL THAT ARRIVES AT THE PREMISES IS ADMINISTERED WITH INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PARASITE CONTROL RELEVANT TO THE SPECIE.

THE RESIDENT HORSES ARE DEWORMED EVERY 3-4 MONTHS, FECAL SAMPLES ARE ALSO TAKEN TO ENSURE THE CORRECT INTERNAL PARASITES ARE CATERED FOR.

THE HOOVES OF THE HORSES ARE DONE EVERY 5-8 WEEKS, INLESS URGENT INTERVENTION IS REQUIRED.

ANIMAL CONDITION AND BEHAVIOUR:

THE ANIMALS OBSERVED APPEARED TO BE IN FAIR CONDITION WITH NO VETERINARY AND/OR HEALTH CONCERNS OBSERVED DURING THE TIME OF OUR INSECTION, EXCEPT FOR ONE DOG (PITBULL, MALE, BROWN/WHITE, ADULT NAMED "DAPPER") WHO IS CURRERNLT UNDER



VETERINARY TREATMENT FOR SARCOPTIC MANGE. THE DOG IS IN A RATHER ADVANCED STAGE AND IS KEPT ISOLATED AND ON CAGE REST.

GENERAL:

THIS IS NOT A STATE-OF-THE-ART SANCTUARY / RESCUE ORGANISATION, HOWEVER, NO CONTRAVENTIONS IN TERMS OF THE ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT 71 OF 1962 WERE OBSERVED DURING THE TIME OF OUR INSPECTION.
