You are hereby warned that:

1. In light of my inspection conducted at Oude Molen Stables on the 23rd of August 2023 the following concerns were observed:

- i. The horse named Blitz appeared to be limping, and it was brought to my attention that Blitz allegedly had a stroke and is currently under treatment by Dr.Lauren. When you were asked for proof of such treatment, you could not provide any proof. Seek Veterinary treatment for your horse named Blitz within 48 hours and provide the SPCA with a veterinary report within the given time frame. Should Blitz already be under treatment, you can send such proof to inspmanager@spca-ct.co.za within 48 hours.
- ii. The horse named Amarah was seen limping on the right back leg When you were asked for proof of such treatment you could not provide any proof. Seek Veterinary treatment for your horse named Amarah within 48 hours and provide the SPCA with a veterinary report within the given time frame. Should Amarah already be under treatment, you can send such proof to inspmanager@spca-ct.co.za within 48 hours.

We remind you to adhere to all the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, & its supporting Regulations at all times.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
