

MUTUAL AGREEMENT

between the

AF Pieters

ID Number: 8612285097089

("The owner")

and

The Cape of Good Hope SPCA

("The SPCA")

I, **AF Pieters** with ID number **8612285097089**, hereby confirm that I am the lawful owner of the Pitbull Cross dog (Admission number A2403), and the Pitbull Cross dog (Admission number A2402) seized by the SPCA on 01 September 2023 with a court order in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, Regulation 468.

The SPCA has agreed to return the above-mentioned dogs into my care on the following conditions set out below:

1. I undertake and commit to the following:
 - a. I am over the age of eighteen (18) years of age and of sound mind.
 - b. I understand that an Inspector from the SPCA will come to my property and conduct an inspection to ensure the enclosure I have constructed for the above-mentioned dogs is of adequate size before the above-mentioned dogs are returned to me.
 - c. My dogs will be kept, at all times, in an area of adequate size which will afford them sufficient space. (*see section 2(1)(b) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962*)
 - d. My dogs will not be kept on chains, under no circumstances whatsoever. (*see section 2(1)(b) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962*)
 - e. I herewith consent to the SPCA sterilising the above-mentioned dogs. I understand that sterilisation is a surgery to make my animal unable to produce offspring. I further confirm that I will not hold the SPCA or its officials liable for sterilising/spaying my animals and/or any complications resulting thereof, and I authorize the use of anaesthetics and other medications, as deemed necessary by the attending veterinarian.

- f. I herewith consent to the SPCA microchipping of the above-mentioned dogs.
- g. An Inspector of the SPCA will be permitted to proactively inspect the above-mentioned dogs at my premises at any reasonable time, with my consent, to ensure their welfare and well-being and to ensure compliance in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.

I confirm that I understand that this mutual agreement does not preclude me from any criminal prosecution. This is a voluntary mutual agreement reached between myself and the SPCA to mediate the matter without involving the courts. I understand that the SPCA reserves the right to proceed with criminal charges against me in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 should I fail to comply with this mutual agreement.

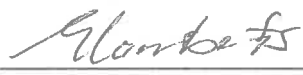
