Comments and action taken by Inspector:

The animals just arrived as I was leaving. Amongst the animals inspected I saw 16 Pygmy Falcons. When asked for any permits, none could be provided. I reported this to CapeNature. While waiting for them to arrive I saw one of the falcons showing signs that he might be in distress. He was hanging from the wired mesh with his back facing the water container. He had rapid breaths and his eyes were closed. This Animal was moved to a different place where there was a draft to keep them cool as we suspected heat stress.

When they arrived, we waited for the person who is supposed to collect the animal. He arrived shortly after them. He says that they are Rescue birds that had been removed from a situation where their welfare were compromised. The ...
