To whom it may concern

On Friday, 5 January 2024 at approximately 21h00, Bruno was surrendered to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA. He originated from 18 Valsheide Street, Roosendal, Delft.

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description** – Bruno has a wound on his chest that responded to stimulus, not only at the stab's site but also the surrounding area, suggesting an infection/abscess may be spreading subcutaneously. The stab appears to only just break the skin, and is about 1.5cm long at the base of the neck on its ventral aspect. The skin is also scraped around the stab site, extending roughly 10 x 15cm.
- **Duration** – Acute
- **Cause** – The cut has sharp margins which could be caused by a stab, but this is not the sole possible cause.
- **Prognosis** – Fair

COMMENTS

On clinical examination, the dog was bright, alert & responsive, with his vital parameters within normal limits. His coat was in good condition, and he had a good body condition score. He had an incision on the ventral aspect of his neck as well as an abrasion surrounding it.

He was sedated, so that the wound area could be shaved and cleaned and explored.

Based on the animal presented to me I believe that the person responsible for this stabbing attempt caused the animal unnecessary suffering.
