You are hereby warned that:

As per the inspection conducted at the prison on 03 September 2024:

- 1) We noted that animals in your care are not receiving their medication on time, as per instruction from the veterinarian. As discussed with members on scene, measures must be put in place as to ensure that animals receive their medication on time and without delay. This must be rectified immediately and maintained thereafter.
- 2) The sleeping kennels must be moved when the enclosures are cleaned to ensure that all fur and urine is removed from the back of the kennels and to keep the kennels in high hygiene standards. This must be rectified within 7 days and a hygienic condition must be maintained thereafter.
- 3) The dip tank must be in working order and the dogs must be dipped regularly as a measure to control external parasites. An alternative ectoparasite should be used in cold or winter months. This must be rectified immediately and maintained thereafter.
- 4) All dogs must be dewormed on a regular basis and a deworming record list/book must be utilised and updated accordingly. This must be rectified immediately and maintained thereafter.

Refer to Section 2(1) of the Animals Protection Act No.71 of 1962 which might be contravened.

We further recommend the following:

- 1) Relief camps should be provided for the dogs to provide them with stimulation and to be able to exercise when the kennels are being cleaned.
- 2) The dogs on your care should be provided with bedding (conveyer belt or mats) to assist with some temperature control and to make it more comfortable for them.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
