Report on Spike Kalamdien

I examined Spike, belonging to Ms Stephanie Kalamdien, on 12 October 2024.

1. Underweight
2. Pruritic with erythema of ventral abdomen and chest, with alopecia
3. Evidence of chewing at the rump with hair discolouration
4. Generalised poor coat condition and scaling
5. Fleas present
6. No evidence of physical abuse

In summary, the main issues are inadequate diet and allergic dermatitis due to fleas and possible other causes such as atopy.

Treatment: dewormer given; Nexguard for skin parasites; Montego food with instructions on quantity to feed. To return for check up in one month for repeat evaluation and vaccination.
