This is an affidavit by Clare Templeton ID 8001030189088 to state that, on the afternoon of the 17/10/2024 at approximately 4pm I was standing talking to a few mothers whilst my children played at the False Bay Rugby Club when we saw a small dog (looked like an old Jack Russell) run past dragging its leg. We looked for its owner but saw no-one. We continued to watch the dog as it ran to the car park and narrowly missed being hit by two cars at which point I couldn't look anymore and I chased the dog and caught it before it could be hit by another car. My friend Rachel recognised the dog from a Facebook post the day before when it had been taken to the Alphen Vet and found running in the road - I have sent a copy of this post to the SPCA.
