

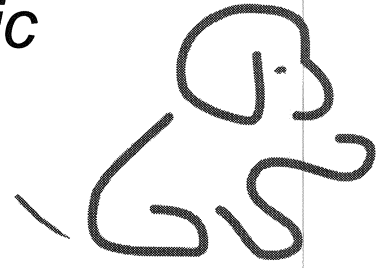

History: Owner presented with all three dogs (Lisa, Nancy and Tessa) under the order for assessment from the SPCA. They are required to be assessed by a veterinary for their skin issues and treated. The report to be sent to SPCA by Monday latest (inspectorate@spca-ct.co.za)

Owner reports that she has sprayed the dogs with Frontline Spray more than a month ago. Occasionally had Nexguard but doesn't want to do it chronically.

Clinical: LISA

Bright, alert and responsive with all vitals within normal limits.

Normal hydration status. Teeth have severe dental disease. Skin & coat - marked alopecia on the caudal spine with a mild number of fleas noted. Rest of clinical including thoracic auscultation, abdominal palpation, lymph nodes, eyes, ears and nose are unremarkable.

Clinical: NANCY

Bright, alert and responsive with all vitals within normal limits. Normal hydration status.

Moderate wear down of the teeth. Skin & coat - Periocular alopecia, moderate alopecia on the caudal spine, marked number of fleas, thickening of the skin on ventral abdomen

Rest of clinical including thoracic auscultation, abdominal palpation, lymph nodes, ears, and nose are unremarkable.

Clinical: TESSA

Bright, alert and responsive with all vitals within normal limits. Normal hydration status. Teeth have mild wear. Skin & coat – marked number of fleas, Hard lump on the LHS of face, Old scar on the left hind. Rest of clinical including thoracic auscultation, abdominal palpation, lymph nodes, eyes, ears and nose are unremarkable.

DISCUSSION

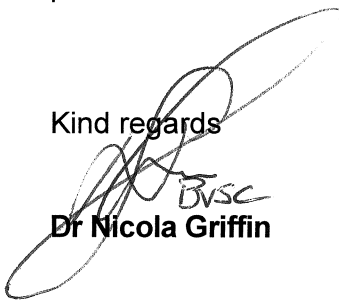
Advised continuous tick and flea control (monthly) to try break cycle. Advised using a spot on or an oral formulation as I don't not feel that the adequate dose is being reached with Frontline spray. Discussed the need to fumigate the environment

Diagnosis - Flea allergic dermatitis

Treatment: Prednisolone and Revolution 10 - 20kg (applied in consult)
