Other factors that can contribute to gingivitis in cats include:

Age: Older cats are more likely to develop gingivitis

Dental care: Cats that don't receive regular dental care, such as brushing or cleanings, are more likely to develop gingivitis

Diet: A low-fiber diet can contribute to gingivitis

Teeth: Crowded or misaligned teeth can increase the risk of gingivitis

Infectious diseases: Feline leukemia virus (FeLV), feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV), or feline calicivirus can cause gingivitis - requested info about tests (2 test minimum 1 m apart)

Autoimmune disorders: Autoimmune diseases can increase the risk of gingivitis

Genetic tendencies: Some cats are more likely to develop dental problems due to genetics

treatment - symptomatic for gingivitis

advice :

- confirm FIV/FeLV status of cat after neuter
- up date vaccinations and start with Felv vacc
- regular flea control
