EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description** of the condition:
Bright alert and responsive
Calm nature, friendly animal
Mucous membranes: Pink, moist
Mild dehydration
Body condition score: Very poor, 3 out of 9 on the Nestle Purina Body System score, ribs and bony prominences of hips and spine clearly seen at a distance, muscle mass loss of face and hind quarters noticed
Coat: Mildly dirty, External parasites (ticks) present
- **Cause:**
Improper and inadequate quantities of diet
Poor external parasite control
- **Duration** of the condition: Chronic
- **Prognosis** – Good if intervention
- **Recommendation** –

If returned to owner:

This animal must be fed a good quality diet to improve body condition and provide essential nutrients that are desperately needed. This animal should come in every 3 weeks to SPCA clinic so we can evaluate improvement and ensure owner has made changes and is providing their pet with basic pet care. Sterilisation is also advised.

This animal was dewormed and given a Vitamin complex injection in our care

COMMENTS

If owner cannot go through with recommendations or fail to upkeep essential basic pet care, the animal should not be returned to them.

This animal has been treated unfairly and has suffered due to the owners failing to provide basic animal care to him.
