You are hereby warned that:

In light of a recent inspection conducted at your facility, **the following was observed and must be rectified within 48 hours unless stated otherwise:**

1. Dog handlers on site were not able to produce a valid DH qualification during the inspection. The dog used for safekeeping was found running off-lead during the inspection which the guard is not qualified to permit. You need to provide relevant documents of the dog handlers for this site within **48 hours**.

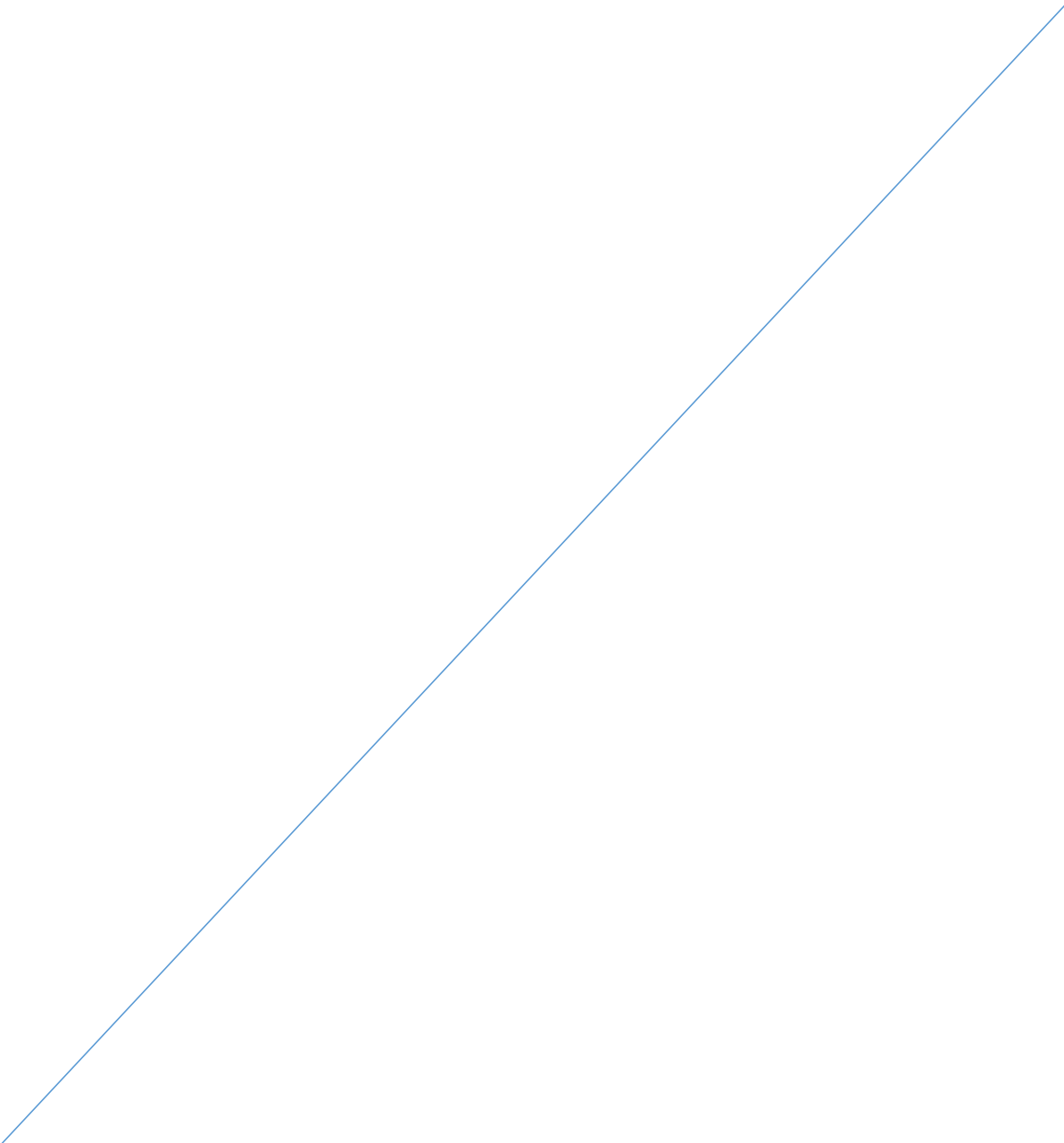
2. The SPCA was informed that the dogs stay on the site. You need to provide a suitable relief camp for the dogs for when they are not on shift and provide environmental enrichment in the camp. You have **48 days** to do so. You are still with this period, you have a further 11 days to action this.

3. Dirty conditions inside and around the enclosures.

a. There was build-up of old hair and sand found inside the enclosures. You need to ensure that cleaning is done thoroughly and the kennels need to be moved at least once a week to deep clean underneath them. When the inspector arrived, the enclosure appeared to be clean but further investigation found that all the dirt and old hair was swept/ hidden underneath the conveyer mat – this is unacceptable. You have **48 hours** to do so.

b. The area around the enclosures were surrounded by overgrown bush. You have **48 hours** to trim and clean the surrounding areas.

4. The middle enclosure was observed to be stuck in the sand so it needs to be lifted to avoid any dirty and/ or parasitic conditions from arising. You have **48 hours** to do so.



This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
