Upon our arrival at the Depot, we met with Noncedo Mbonana, a Security Gaurd for Securitem, the security company hired by the Depot. Cadet Abrahams asked to see the PAPA license and proof of Dog Handling certificates, which was provided. He asked for the dog's working times and what times the dog is rested/ relieved. Working times 21:00 to 04:00 the next morning is when the dog works - when she is working she is free roaming inside the Depot. Her rest times are from 04:00 until 21:00. In her rest times she is kept in the enclosure. Abrahams asked how often she is walked and let out of the enclosure when she isn't working. Noncedo told him she is only able to take the dog out when the Depot isn't busy and when it is quiet, she let's her out completely. Upon our approach to the enclosure, the dog was found sleeping. Good condition. Clean enclosure, food and water. Conveyor belt flooring. Shade netting around sides. Abrahams addressed that signage must be placed on enclosure. Abrahams issued Notice 13452 for confirmation of dog being let out of her enclosure frequently during her relief times by form of written proof within 7 days, to secure signage exhibiting dog's details on enclosure, and to contact the SPCA to further discuss the matter. Cadet Abrahams and I will be contacting the manager of the company to discuss formal rest times for the dog, however, no welfare concerns noted during the inspection.
