On my arrival, I was welcomed by the woman who Introduced herself as Deacon Abraham's, she allowed me onto the property, she told me that, the property belongs to her father who is residing on the other property.

She told me that, her cousin, brought two puppies onto the property, and that was never discussed with them as the family,

She showed me the puppies that appeared to be in a fair condition, they were confined in a very small space, there was no proper shelter, it was a makeshift shelter that appeared to be not adequate against the elements. Inside the enclosure there was clean water.

Deacon took me to the left side of the property, to show me the rubble. The was not happy with puppies being kept onto the property, she mentioned that, she has children and they can't play outside now as usual, I wanted to know from the complainant what she would like us to do, she wanted me to take the puppies, at the very same time when the owner is at home.

I told her that, taking the puppies will never be a problem, however based on what I have observed, the owner might come to claim the puppies and it might difficult to say no, when he claimed the puppies.

I then called Emma looking for her advice. She told to tell the owner to come back home immediately I'm order to discuss the matter, or the Deacon need to surrender the puppies, or we treat the case as normal, Deacon was not comfortable to surrender the puppies or to call the owner, she advised me to issue a warning.

While I was still at the property, young man who introduced himself as Raafiq Abraham's, he arrived and claimed that he owned one of the puppies, then Immediately Deacon left us.

I wanted to him to showed me the puppy food, he went inside and came back with a epol puppy food, he claimed that, he mixed it with gravy or water.

I told him that, him and Moesfee, within 48 hours,

1. they need to provide the puppies with proper and adequate shelter against the elements, within 48 hours.
2. To remove all the hazardous materials and the rubble that was onto the property within 48 hours.
3. To provide the puppies with adequate space within 48 hours.
4. To take both dog to the veterinarian for vaccination within 48 hours.

The warning was signed and accepted by Raafiq.
