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On my arrival, I met with a man who Introduced himself as Roman Van Rooyen, with ID no 49 0918 5658 983. He claimed to be the owner of the property as well as the owner of the animals at the property.

He allowed me onto the property, and said, he was at the SPCA today, to do a follow up on his dog on dog, that he would to adopt it

However, he was told at the SPCA to pay the amount of R850.00 whereas he had R500.00, he wanted me to out nice words on behalf of him, I said to him, he needs to let me inspect his animals, he then agreed,

He took me to the back of the house, where i have observed about 25 pigeons. 2 of them appeared to have cere on their beak, something that looked not normal, although the owner said, it is normally for racing Pigeon.

I have posted the Pigeon with cere on the SPCA group, as i was not sure,

Rudy responded and said, it appeared as if there is a welfare concern, then Nicole went to Google the cere, and found out that, white cere is normal for a racing Pigeon.

Then I didn't issue warning. The living environment of the Pigeons was not that bad, there were few dropping of faeces and there was clean water.

There was a dog called Below, female sterilized, she appeared to be cream white in color, the dog appeared to old, the owner claimed that she is more than(15) fifteen years.

The dog was kept in the enclosure that is 3 by 1 meter, the owner claimed that the dog like to run away from the property. I find it yo be not acceptable as be the property appeared to be well fenced,

I have instructed the owner to let the dog to roam freely inside the property immediately, he agreed, and said, he will put the dog on there when he is pulling in or out, then as soon as he is done, he will let the dog roam freely inside the property

The warning was issued as follows.

1. You have no valid reason to confine your dog into the cage, as your property is fully fenced, let the dog to roam freely inside the property immediately, the owner complied
