General Report Comments: On my arrival, I have met with a man who introduced himself as Melvyn Walsh, he claimed to be the owner of the animals as well as the owner of the property, after I have told him the nature of the complaint, he allowed me onto the property.

Inside the house, I have observed a unsterilized cat called Bubu, the cat appeared to be in a fair condition, there was drinkable water as well as the food for the cat.

I have advised the owners about the sterilization, they were interested, however they mentioned that they do not have money, they further mentioned that the last time they enquired about the sterilization, they were told to pay R350.00, according to the owners that was too much,

they also mentioned that they owned two dogs that are also not sterilized, I wanted to know from them, if how they can afford for all three animals, they couldn't answer me, I told them that we may assist them by sterilizing the animals if they can pay R500.00 for all the animals.

Melvin, seemed to be not interested on sterilizing the dogs, I explained the benefits of sterilizing the animals, I also explained the Animal Keeping bylaws, still Melvyn was still not that interested.

From the house, we have proceeded to the back of the house, where I have observed two unsterilized males (Pitbulls), both dogs were roaming freely at the back.

The dog called Osman appeared to be under weight, the owner claimed that he bought the deworm pills last week and dewormed the dog, I wanted to see the proof of the pills, he showed me, I took a picture of the pills. I have advised the owner to increase the amount of food that he gives to the dogs, especially the dog called Osman.

The dog called Adam appeared to be in a fair condition, there was drinkable water provided to the dogs, there were wooden shelters also provided to the dogs. However the living environment was not clean, there were hazardous materials that may cause unnecessary injuries to the dogs.

The warning was issued as follows.

1. To provide the animals with adequate food on a daily basis and the puppy food was recommended as the dog appeared to be thin.
 2. To remove all the hazardous materials within 72 hours.
- We need to collect the animals for sterilization when we conduct the follow up inspection.
