General Report Comments: At the time of inspection I met with owners mother Diedre Niewenhys 7101220187081 cellphone 0719884025 and addressed welfare concerns received regarding the animals on the property.

She allowed me inside the property to conduct an inspection on the animals and I observed a male xbreed dog by the name of outjie that appeared to have a swollen face and appeared to be struggling to breath properly. I Questioned the condition of the dog and was informed by the owners mother that the dig was allegedly beaten by someone in the area but they do not know who. I asked when was that and she claimed a month ago, I asked her has the dig seen the veterinarian after the incident and I was informed that the owner was unable to do so due to being busy at work, I informed her that unfortunately that was supposed to be done immediately after the incident happened or called a nearby Welfare Society to assist them with matter at hand other than to leave the dog to suffer like this unnecessary. The dog had drinkable water available and shelter available, the digs body score was fair but also slightly underweight.

I observed a xbreed tan/white puppy that was also on the property in its own area that appeared to be underweight as ribs were Slightly visible. The dog appeared to be depressed amd stool passed by the dog was watery with blood in it as well, the smell coming off the area was awful and it appeared to me that the dog might have parvolike symptoms.

I was give the owmer the number to call and spoke to him regarding the matter at hand regarding the animals on the property. He claimed that he tried calling the spca for the dog but was informed that he needs to nring the dig in himself if unable to provide the donation collection fee which he had. I informed him that he was supposed to make a plan for the dig as it suffered unnecessarily and he wanted me to take the dogs bit i needed confirmation from his thorough the phone as our lines are recorded to which he give his mother the consent to sign the digs over to the SPCA for PTS. The mother did the paperwork as well and aparently the dig stays with the owmers mother during the day which she also saw the dog suffer but did nothing.

I left a warning also stating that whenever you have a sick or injured animal you are to seek vetinary attention without any delays or surrender the dog over to the SPCA. I also said that they also confirm that the dig in question has been like that for atleast a month and she signed.

Dogs have been taken to the SPCA for our veterinarians to assess amd advise , a veterinarian report will be requested as well
