I have observed 2 dogs onto the property, the first called was called Bullet, the dog appeared to have the following concerns to be underweight, to be developing skin condition, to have healing wounds.

The owner claimed that the children on the road, they like to take the dog for a walk and ended up in a fight. I told him that, he need to be responsible, by making sure that he protect the dog from dog fighting.

The dog was kept in front of the house in the enclosure that appeared to be adequate, there was no water, the living environment was not clean, there was rubble or hazardous material that may cause unnecessary injuries to the dog. There was makeshift shelter

I also the puppy, that appeared to be in a fair condition, the puppy sleep inside the house.

The warning was issued as follows.

1. To provide the dogs with adequate food.
2. To provide the dogs with drinkable water at all times.
3. To take the dog called Bullet to the vet within 72 hours.
4. To clean the living environment within 72 hours.
5. To refrain from baiting, inciting or provoking any animal to attack another or to allow any animal to attack another one as it is not permitted to do so.
