General Report Comments: I was accompanied by Law Enforcement, Albertyn, Alexander and Abraham's, on our arrival, we knock from the gate, a young man came out to us, we told him that we have a warrant that gives powers to enter onto the property and to conduct the inspection, the young man said, we need to wait for few minutes,

I told him that there is no waiting time, waiting is now over, I have opened the gate, we then proceeded into the property.

Where we have observed the dog that was chained up on a static short chain, the dog appeared to underweight and he appeared to have black spots on his canine teeth. There was no shade provided to the dog, and the dog was forced to sit in the shelter that is very warm.

Around the dog there was rubble, the hazardous materials that may cause the injuries to the dog and there were old faeces.

One of the young man who introduced himself as Lee- Roy Louw, called the actually owner (Jacques Andrews), who wanted to know what was happening, Lee Roy handed the cellphone over me, I have spoken to the actually owner,

I have told him the whole story, he sounds very upset against the caretaker who was acting as if he owned the property, he even mentioned that, he is the owner of the dog as well as the owner of the property, he mentioned that, he buy everything for the dog,

he further mentioned that, this was not going to happen If the caretaker told him about us, he said, it is not a difficult thing to take the dog to the vet if the dog needs that, he wanted to know the way forward,

I told him that, we are going to confiscate the dog, then he will have to come to SPCA to claim the dog.

We have removed the dog and the following documents were given to Lee-Roy

1. Copy of the Warrant with my statement and Julian's statement.
2. The Seizure Notice with Regulation 468.

Then I have proceeded to the Police station to obtain the OB No as 3794/11 /2024
