General Report Comments: At the time of inspection I met with a lady by the name of Annelise Booysen (owners wife) and she was busy cleaning and giving water to the dogs upon my arrival. I came out of the vehicle and she immediately claimed that said you not the same guy that just walked in and took pictures of my the dogs without our approval, I informed her that unfortunately this is my first time on the property and that I'm here to discuss a welfare concern that we recieved regarding the animals on the property. She allowed me inside the property to conduct an inspection on the animals in which we went inside but the community was all out which made me abit uneasy as there were certain dodgey individuals amongst them but I still went ahead to conduct an inspection.

I observed 2 x Rotti type dogs by the names zeena and lucky who both appeared to be underweight as ribs were visible, the dogs were also seen on the property on static chains which "lucky" appeared to be on a approximately 2m chain and "zeena" on a approximately 1.5 but entangled. The dogs appeared to be aggressive especially the adult bitch, the dogs did not have suitable collars around their necks as well as they had chokers/raw chains. There was shelter available for the dogs but it was not adequate due to amount of animals on the property and exposed areas as well.

I noticed that the owner was present on the phone as well during my inspection and discussion with his wife, he also added that they got the dog like that and they've been trying to feed him and got a deworm for it the day it arrived, I was also shown by the wife the dogs food as well which has was ipol adult. I advised that they need to deworm again and try to change the dogs food to atleast puppy as it contains alot of protein as well but the dog does not gain weight within given timeframe owner is to seek veterinary attention for the dogs.

I issued a warning stating that the owner should within 20 days:

1. Deworm and adequately feed the animals on the property (preferably puppy food)
2. Provide both dogs with a running chain as well and suitable collars (refer to leaflet given)
3. Provide suitable shelter fir the dogs as well

NB:OWNER WAS ALSO ADVISED IF DOGS DO NOT GAIN WEIGHT WITHIN THE GIVEN TIME FRAME HE IS TO SEEK VETINARY ATTENTION FOR THE DOGS
