General Report Comments: Upon my arrival, I met with a woman who was immediately defensive. At first she denied me access but then I let her air out her frustration and she let me inside. I observed 4 kittens confined to 1 area of her house. There were wooden crates inside but they were within the crates. The crates are dirty with loose faeces and dirty water. Malisa said she places I saw bread and milk in a plate in the floor and told Malisa this could cause diarrhea. Malisa said she only provides the cats with milk and bread sometimes so that they don't become addicted to typical food. She also gives them chicken, Pellets, and tin food. She showed me vaccination records and sterilization records for 2 of her cats. The kittens' mother was not sterilised because she ran away when TEARS came to collect them. It must be noted that Malisa tried to insinuate that this was a racial matter. The kittens are going to be sterilised at TEAR in 3 weeks and then they are being given away.
