I have met with a woman who Introduced herself as Zainap Dollie, she claimed to be the mother of Sedick Davids, who is the owner of the dog, According to Zainap, Sedick was at the work.

She allowed me onto the property, where I have observed two animals as follows a dog and a cat at the property,

The dog is called Bou, he was sterilized by Cape of Good Hope SPCA, the dog appeared to be developing skin condition on his back left leg and around his body, Zainap claimed that, they are using spray that they bought at the pet shop to control the skin condition, I wanted her to show me the spray, unfortunately the spray was there,

I told her that, they will have to take the dog to the veterinarian for adequate treatment.

The dog was kept at the right side of the house, on the alleyway that could be 1.5 by 10 meters, The living environment was not clean, there were hazardous material that may cause unnecessary injuries to the dog,

I have told them to remove all the hazardous materials and keep the living environment clean at all times.

and they need to provide us with the veterinarian report. The dog is a shelter from outside and he also allowed inside the house, there was drinkable water for the dog.

The cat appeared to be in a fair condition, there was water and there was food provided to the cat

The warning was issued as follows.

1. To take the dog to the veterinarian for adequate treatment within 72 hours.
2. To remove all the hazardous materials within 72 hours and keep the living environment clean at all times.

It appeared as if the SPCA had been at the property many times, the owners of the animals know the Chief Jaco Pieterse, they know Inspector Elani.
