I was accompanied by Officer Abrahams from LE ACU. Upon our arrival to the property at approximately 12:50, we rang the doorbell at the gate and tried to look over the wall. A woman came out, and there was a little Jack Russel Puppy following her. We introduced ourselves and explained why we were there. She said her name was Geraldine and explained she worked for the owners of the puppy and the property. I then asked for the owners' numbers so I could call them. She gave me the number for Stephan and Sandy Terblanche - 071 677 5831. Sandy answered the phone, and I explained we were just there to conduct a follow-up inspection. She expalined that Inspector Lee found no concerns and

took photos of the puppy's bowls and shelter. I asked her if we could do the same just to close the case from our side, and she told Geraldine to let us in. The puppy is a female Jack Russel who is unsterilised. She is white with brown and her name is Bonnie. Bonnie is in good condition and followed us through the house and to her kennel and water. The water provided is clean and is in clean containers. We also noted the various toys in the yard and the house. Bonnie has access to a kennel and water at all times. No welfare concerns were noted during the inspection and it was evident that the puppy has access to shelter, water, and toys. Sandy explained that when they put her outside to clean, she cries. This is typical puppy behaviour. Photos will be uploaded when WT is working again. No welfare concerns, and this case can be closed - NFA.
