we have met with the mother of Zuresh, she was with her daughter. The owner of the dog was not at home, the Chief told the mother to call her son, the mother said he doesn't have a cellphone, his cell was caught on fire yesterday.

we have told her that we have a warrant, that we have obtained at the Wynberg Court

I have told her that we need to do inspection on the animals, she allowed us to enter into the property.

We have proceeded to the back of the house, when i have noticed that the shack that was at the back of house was burnt down, as well as the car parts were also burnt down,

Where the dog was kept, there were ashes, I was convinced that the dog was caught on fire as It was exactly where there was ashes, we have searched the property without getting the dog.

We wanted to know from the mother and her daughter what happened , both they mentioned that, they do not know what happened,

I wanted to know about the dog, the mother told me that, Zuresh took the dog to another property.

We have observed 6 chickens, 5 ducks and a sheep, the sheep appeared to be thin, all the animals were confined in a cage that was not adequate for all animals, there was no food, there was no clean water, there was less ventilation, the living environment was dirty.

We had to remove all the above animals, based on their living environment.

While we were loading the animals, the owner arrived, The chief wanted to know about the dog, he confined that the dog died last night, he mentioned that, he took the carcass to bury it in Phillip, we wanted him to take us to the grave site, then he agreed.

On our arrival, we have observed the dog dog was dead, the dog still had the chain around neck, the dog was not buried more that it was dumped on Schaap Raod Phillip, the dog was wrapped with a white and red blanket, the dog was badly Injured,

The Law Enforcement officers, had to arrest the accused, then we have proceeded to base to drop the carcass, we then proceeded to the Police station to open a docket.
