General Report Comments: Upon arrival I met owner who gave me access onto property. He told me that he has not yet taken the dog to the vet as he has not yet had the money, but that he refuses to surrender his dog. I observed the dog in question who still appears to be unwell. I then observed a second dog who appears to be covered in ticks and fleas. He belongs to the brother. The dogs have access to adequate water and a clean living environment. They sleep under the carport as shelter.

I then issued a NTC for Bruno's owner: Provide your dog Bruno with adequate veterinary treatment within 72hours to avoid further action being taken.

- 2) Provide proof of such treatment to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA within given time frame .
- 3) Should you not be able to provide your animal with above mentioned you have the option to surrender the dog to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA to prevent further unnecessary suffering .
- 4) Provide your dog with adequate shelter as the shelter seen is not adequate. You have 7days to do so.

I then issued a NTC for the other dog's owner:Provide your dog Pablo with adequate external parasite treatment as he appears to have ticks and fleas within 72hours.

- 2) Provide proof of such treatment to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA within above given time frame .
- 3) Provide your dog with adequate shelter as the carport he uses is not adequate as it does not protect him against all weather. You have 7days to do so.
