They told me that since it's still a kid, the goat don't drink from a bowl yet and they bottle feed him every hour 2-3 bottles of water. They also showed me the bottle. They told me that his mother died so they afraid that the other goats will bully him so they bring him with to the stand. I explained to them that its still unnecessary confinement as the goat could've been free roaming if they left him home. The goat appeared in a fair condition.

I issued a warning to leave the goat at home and refrain from tethering the goat as it is unnecessary which is a contravention of the animals protection act.
