 White blood cells seem low in number
 Platelets seem to be in normal numbers

Summary of findings:

Patient is emaciated and anaemic
 The anaemia is non-regenerative
 On examination, no cause for the non-regenerative anaemia can be found. However, it could be attributed to malnutrition.

Orthopedic exam: Severe muscle wasting. Patient has prominent ribs, hip bones and wasting of the temporal muscles
