In light of our inspection conducted on the 02 February 2024, the following concerns were observed and must be rectified at the address within 7 days. This is in conjunction with a previous inspection conducted by Inspector Carina Bodenstein that shows not much has been done.

You are hereby warned that:

- 1). The cages where the dogs are confined are too small and does not provide the dogs with adequate and sufficient roaming space.
 - 1.1 These cages must be enlarged to provide the dogs with sufficient space.
- 2.) There are large holes and wiring on the floor and sides of the enclosures.
 - 2.1 These holes must be covered or fixed or filled to prevent unnecessary injuries.
- 3.) The kennels and enclosures do not provide sufficient shelter against the weather elements.
 - 3.1 Additional coverage from the side and top must be provided.
 - 3.2 All kennels provided were broken and had planks missing in the floor and sides. This needs to be fixed to prevent unnecessary injuries.
- 4.) The following dog appeared to be underweight and must be assessed by a veterinarian, as the dog might be suffering from underlying medical conditions.
 - 4.1 "Seun"
- 5) Hazardous material and overgrown vegetation were observed throughout the living environment where the dogs are kept, including broken cages, cleaning equipment, dirty water holes, broken down car, etc.
 - 5.1 Clean the yard from hazardous material and overgrown vegetation as to prevent injury or parasitic conditions.

We remind you to adhere to all the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935 (as amended in 2016) & its supporting Regulations and the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By-Law at all times.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
