I observed one hamster that was dead in its enclosure. The staff advised that this hamster had recently escaped and they only found him yesterday. The hamster was then put in his enclosure until I found him dead this morning. I advised them that they must find a way to prevent the animals from escaping and if they do, they must be closely monitored to ensure they are healthy.

I also saw one dead fish in the tanks. They were not sure why this fish died.
