History:

Jack has been surrendered to the rescue facility to retire three months ago. He was underweight and difficult to feed.

Clinical exam:

His heart rate and respiration rate are normal. Temperature normal. Colour normal. Jack is still very thin with a body condition score of 2.5. He can eat his food normally, but his teeth are sharp and require doing. They have not been done for 18 months and the dentist is apparently due next week. His feet are fine, and he is sound in hand. He is alert and happy in the paddock. Although he is very thin, he has apparently gained 7 kg's since being here and has been dewormed.

I have recommended that the amount of lucerne he gets is increased as there is a chance he could be suffering from gastrointestinal ulcers. I have also advised that he gets lunch to help increase the number of calories he consumes.
