

Landikhaya Security is hereby issued a formal warning letter, mandating the immediate removal of all dogs from sites. Furthermore, Landikhaya Security is required to initiate the process of having the dogs professionally trained by a certified training centre, have all SOPs according to the PAPA requirements, and ensure the provision of an adequate number of dog handlers, with a ratio of three handlers per dog. Upon fulfilment of these conditions, Landikhaya Security must proceed to apply for a PAPA license.

Please be advised that, as the individual accountable for the business operations, it is your responsibility to adhere to all pertinent legislation consistently. Non-compliance with the warnings issued by PSIRA and this letter could potentially subject you to prosecution under the Performing Animals Protection Act (Act no. 24 of 1935). The welfare of the dogs is our primary concern. We look forward to receiving your application for a PAPA licence in the near future and your continued cooperation regarding the dogs under your care.
