On the 23 April I examined a tan male neutered Pitbull type dog called "Wrinkles". His clinical examination showed a body condition score of 4/10. He had diffuse chronic dermatitis on his dorsum. He had a laceration on his dorsal neck. This wound was explored under anaesthetic and extended to ventrolateral aspect of right cranial neck. There was severe haemorrhage from the wound as it extended into the muscle and on to wing of atlas vertebra. The wound also extended ventrally on left hand side of neck within subcutaneous tissue. There was a small laceration on dorsal head. The right pupil was miotic.

The wounds were consistent with the described trauma of stabbing.

The wounds were flushed and sutured under general anaesthetic and appropriate antibiotics and analgesia were provided.

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
