You are hereby warned that:

During an inspection at the Kennel Union of South Africa National IGP national event based at the Kraaifontein Rugby Club, Sarel Van Deventer Road in Kraaifontein the following concerns were observed:

1. The dogs may not be left in the trailers or vehicles for the duration of the dog show. The dogs must be allowed out of the trailers and vehicles frequently to stretch and move around. In future shows of this kind, alternative arrangements must be made so that the dogs are not left in the trailers or vehicles for the duration of the show and the participants must be informed accordingly.
2. No person shall display or exhibit an animal for show unless such person is the holder of a permit issued by the City of Cape Town in terms of Section 12 of the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By Law, 2021. No permit could be presented during the show. Kindly take note that in future a permit must be obtained from the City of Cape Town, or such show will not be permitted to continue. Please refer to Section 12 of the City of Cape Town's Animal Keeping By-Law, 2021:

12. Displaying or exhibiting of an animal for show or financial gain

- (1) No person shall display or exhibit an animal for show or financial gain in a public space or public road, unless such person is the holder of a permit issued by the City or Cape Nature. This includes the use of an animal for begging or fundraising purposes. In the event that the City receives an application from a person for the displaying or exhibiting of an animal for show or financial gain they shall consult an animal welfare Inspector authorised in terms of Section 8(1) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 for comment and input.

We remind you to adhere to all the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935 (as amended in 2016) & its supporting Regulations and the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By-Law at all times.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
