Comments by Inspector:

I was contacted at approximately 9h20am by Inspector Jason to go to this site as it is a new site. Upon arrival at given address accompanied by Mr. Thembi we met a young boy (15plus minus) and questioned him about the sheep being sold/ slaughtered at this farm and at first he told us that they do not sell/ slaughter any animals, buy then we said we observed a sign on the way in which says 'sheep for sale'. He then told us that they meant to remove the sign. We then asked him whether if they have any animals and yes said nothing at the moment. We then asked where the animals are kept and he pointed to an open field across the road. We then asked to see where the animals were kept if not across the road for grazing purposes. The then told us he would call his father.

We then saw another young boy(15plus minus) and questioned him whether if there were any animals being sold here and he said yes. We asked whether if there are any animals on the property at currently and he said yes plenty and pointed us in the right direction. Going into the facility we observed a group of men gathered around a slaughtered bull. We then approached a adult male and questioned with regards to animals being slaughtered and sold and he too told us that the seen bull is the last animal on rhe premises.

As we were about to leave I saw the you boy we first spoke to and questioned him about his father. He then called his father who said he is the owner of this place who also said the seen bull is the last animal on the property.

We then left property as we did not see or hear any other animals.

To our conclusion: someone is to go to this property earlier that what we did to see whether if they have animals for sale or slaughter as both myself and Mr. Thembi was very suspicious about how the questions were answered and that they did might be withholding information.
