No. of animals seen:

Going off the end of the previous day then there should be approximately **37 Sheep** and **5 Goats** remaining. **0 Cattle**. However, I didn't get to reinspect properly and confirm new numbers.

Confinement of animals:

Caged - adequate space - appeared to be the same as previous inspection but didn't get to reinspect properly. The caged animals were still for Qurbani.

Adequate space available:

Yes - appeared to be the same as previous inspection but didn't get to reinspect properly.

Clean living environment:

Yes - appeared to be the same as previous inspection but didn't get to reinspect properly.

Water available:

Didn't get to reinspect properly and confirm.

Adequate shelter available:

Yes - appeared to be the same as previous inspection but didn't get to reinspect properly.

Animals in good condition:

Yes - appeared to be the same as previous inspection but didn't get to reinspect properly.

Veterinary problems / Health concerns:

Didn't get to reinspect properly and confirm.

General comments:

Upon my arrival, I met with Asa Johnson and Nabelah Johnson and provided them with a Qurbani guide for guidance on humane handling and slaughter (as per the previous warnings issued to them).

Whilst there, I also caught one of their clients cleaning out sheep faeces from his boot and I issued him with a warning for unacceptable transport of animals.

However, I could not properly reinspect the housing and slaughter of the animals and I was dispatched to another site to provide Inspector Taljaard with an additional humane stunner as his site was going to slaughter another large bull (1,7 tonnes).

After dropping the humane stunner off, I was assigned to Moeratgani Livestock so that Inspector Philander could be assigned to another site for stunning.

AWS Inspector Julian Van Der Zandt was then asked to follow up on Johnson Farm thereafter. I notify Julian of the concerns at Johnson Farm.
