Comments by Inspector:

The inspection had been carried out by Thembi and Sivu (AWS). Peace and Bongzi also joined them a bit later on. They inspected the four blind goats identified and isolated upon previous inspections. The goats are still being treated, however, the treatment doesn't seem to be working. Another limping sheep was identified and euthanized by SPCA staff.

The other concerns were related to transportation. The facility provides blindfolds for the animals. The people buying the animals doesn't have proper transportation with sufficient ventilation. These concerns were addressed immediately and rectified prior to them loading the animals.

No contraventions observed during the time of the inspection.
