Isolated five animals that were compromised. One sheep with an eye injury and four other sheep that was seen limping.

The four goats was still not slaughtered. I spoke to the owner, he advised that he is not prepared to slaughter the animals without selling them as he does not want to loose money. He also advised that he will not get the veterinarian out as that will also cost money. He advised that there will be someone to buy them today, a guy called Benjamin. Benjamin had to leave to get the money to pay for the goats, he said he will be back at 15h00.

I issued the owner with another warning, giving them until 15h00 to have the goats slaughtered. I also addressed the five compromised sheep in my warning and suggested that they do daily checks to identify and deal with compromised animals accordingly. I will return later today to follow up on the goats.

When I arrived the person who was said to buy the goats have not yet arrived. The manager, Martin, contacted Benjamin and he said he is on his way.

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
