~~They observed and addressed some handling issues with the staff. Excessive chasing was observed.~~

~~Issues with transportation were observed and addressed. Some of the vehicles didn't have non slip flooring and vehicles are used without making provision of suitable ventilation. This had been rectified prior to animals being loaded.~~
