Comments by Inspector:

This inspection had been carried out by Julian from AWS initially. Later on in the day he was joined by Ferrent, Bongsi, Peace and Thembi.

They identified three compromised animals during their inspection. One sheep had nasal discharge and two other sheep were seen to be limping. All three these animals were slaughtered that same day.

Other issues included water being poured on the open wound of the animals directly after they cut their throat. This was addressed with the owner and he was educated as to why this is a problem. They then stopped doing this after they spoke to them.

No other contraventions observed during this day. All the animals had access to food, water and shelter. No concerns observed during the inspection of transportation.
