On Tuesday the 17th of July 2024 I was presented with two dogs confiscated from 91 Tulip Street Lentegur.

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

Animal: Meisie (A35184)

- **Description:** She is a Bright, alert, responsive and playful puppy. Body condition 4 on the Nestle Purina Body System. Fleas were present on coat. Adequate hydration on skin tent. Mucous membranes were pink and moist. Other clinical parameters were within normal limits
- **Prognosis:** Good to excellent if adequate care is provided and routine health care is followed.
- **Recommendation:** In our care Meisie was dewormed and was treated with tick and flea prevention. She will remain at the SPCA for safekeeping under the instruction of SPCA Inspector Jeffrey.

Animal: Vista (A35183)

- **Description:** Vista presented with watery black diarrhoea and was dehydrated. Body condition score 3 on the Nestle Purina Body System. He was negative for distemper and parvovirus. These tests were done because vaccination history is unknown. We suspect gastroenteritis or gastric ulcers as the cause of his condition. She has been treated with anti-inflammatories, ulcer medication, diarrhoea suspension, appetite stimulants and fluid therapy via a drip.

- **Prognosis:** Good
- **Recommendation:** In our care She was treated for her diarrhoea and dewormed. Tick and flea treatment was also administered. There has been marked improvement in her condition. Treatment is still ongoing. She will be moved to kennels for keeping for 7 days as instructed by SPCA Inspector Jeffrey.
