I carried out the inspection at the sale yard. I was accompanied by three Cadet inspectors. We introduced ourselves at the reception and was granted access by Carl Malherbe.

During the inspection we addressed handling concerns with o e of the handlers. He didn't want to listen to us and will be addressed in the warning. Another new staff member also made handling errors. Handling concerns related to prodding sheep and pulling them by the legs. These were addressed and rectified immediately.

Concerns relating to vehicles were also identified and addressed. Concerns relating to no non slip flooring. These were addressed and rectified prior to them loading any animals.

Approximately 20 calves were seen to be sold that were unweaned. They were not sold with their mothers. I got the details of the person selling them and
