ON THE 16TH OF SEPTEMBER 2024, I WAS ON DUTY IN FULL UNIFORM ATTENDING TO COMPLAINTS WITH THE SPCA. AT APPROXIMATELY 13H00 I ATTENDED TO A COMPLAINT WITH SPCA INSPECTOR TALJAARD AT 8 WARD LANE, GRASSY PARK. UPON ARRIVAL, WE WERE GRANTED ACCESS BY ONE OF THE TENANTS AND WE FOUND A BLACK AND BROWN DOG IN THE BACKYARD, CHAINED TO A METAL POLE CLOSE TO A SHELTER FOR THE DOG. I knocked on a door and a young man who was later identified as Marcel Edwin Leo told me that the owner is not home. I then went to Winkburg Magistrates court to obtain a court order.
