Hi,
This case has now taken months to get anywhere.
Thank you for responding to it.
It's just a pity though that the reason I reported it has not been dealt with.
I am attaching a photo of the premises again, as I am beginning to think that the inspector has gone to the wrong place.
The issue is about 2 dogs at this white brick house, chained up and not having sufficient shading daily for a very long time now.
It is on the slopes of Hangberg, Hout bay, in an illegally constructed area.

I phoned on 11 January about case 192882.
I was informed that an inspector went to the location on 2 January 2024.
I was told that they observed that there was water and kennels. They instructed that a running wire should be erected.
I think they saw the 2 plastic kennels and presumed it was sufficient shading. The brown dog knocks his contraption over every day, also the kennels are like saunas in this hot weather, it's definitely not proper shading. The black dog has or had puppies.
The follow up inspection was supposed to be on 11 January.

I don't think there was any inspection, everything is still the same. The brown dog still barks constantly asking for help.

I know this is not a serious issue for the Spca, because you deal with way more severe cases than this, so I appreciate it that you are making the effort to deal with this. Is it possible to give me feedback please.
