I hope this message finds you well.

Thank you for reaching out to us, and please accept my sincere apologies for the delay in responding. Your concern for the well-being of animals is deeply appreciated.

I want to assure you that your message has been taken seriously. Our inspectors, including myself, were indeed attending to a situation on a livestock vessel in Cape Town Harbour, which caused a slight delay in addressing your inquiry.

I have looked into the matter and can confirm that the SPCA has not requested the microchip details of the dog. We are unsure as to why the owner will use the SPCA name for this information. Be it as it may, this was not a request from the SPCA.

With regards to the procedure the dog underwent. A full investigation was undertaken, and our Inspector also visited the property and interviewed the attending veterinarian. The attending veterinarian confirmed that the procedure was undertaken for medical reasons and not cosmetic reasons.

The case is closed on our side. The SPCA can only act if there is intentional abuse or contraventions in terms of the Animals Protection Act.
