General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property by no. 11 where we actually received the complaint, i met with Debbie who is the actual complainant and she mentioned that she unfortunately released one of the peacocks that was brought in by Fred baileys (The shooter) wife and was claimed to be bleeding and injured, but no one has ever witnessed it happen.

Upon my inspection i observed approximately 9 peacocks freely roaming in a open space/ opening, which all of them appeared to be in fair condition and non of them had any signs of post or present injuries.

As per the complainant, Mr Baileys wife claimed that her husband had shot the peacock and apparently this is not the first time this had ocured and previously one had died from these actions. Debbie also claims that there is a voice recording claiming that he was going to kill one of the Peacocks, since they "bother" him at night.

I thetefore requested that Debbe,the complainant and if she is contact with Mr Baileys wife, provide the SPCA with Statements from SAPS explaining what happened and their observation of the animal.

No Warning or Notice has been issued for this case as it needs to be discussed with Area Supervisor on Tuesday.
