Comments:	I managed to locate the 2 youngsters with a 2 month old brindle puppy, it appears to be in fair condition despite showing very slight signs of a possible skin condition. They had (2) bottles of clean drinking water with them and enough food for themselves and the dog. My outright concern was that they were directly exposed to the blazing sun, whereupon I warned them to seek shade under a tree on the lawn area to which they complied. As the PPA security staff members approached together with a few family members , they got up an literally ran off with the dog. I explained, and made it quite clear to the family members that our initial intention and concern was first and foremost the welfare of the little puppy, whereupon they all acknowledged and agreed. In the presence of the family members and PPA security officers these youngsters have been warned (verbally) to vacate the area with their dog, failing which they risk the dog being seized from them.
