General Report Comments: Upon arrival, Ms Frederick's granted me access. She showed me the shelter for the dogs which appears to be adequate. She said that 4 of the dogs are leaving so 3 will remain. The dogs were also separated as outlined in the notice. However she did not take the injured dog to a veterinary clinic. She told me that she called tears but they told her they are only open for emergencies. She says she's not able to take the dog alone and her partner is away. The dog in question appears to have fluid build up on the one leg with the most bite wounds and the other leg has inflammation due to wounds. I told her that if she takes the dog to a clinic before we return she must inform us. I also advised her that it is up to the inspector to decide if a warrant will be obtained due to failing to comply with the most recent notice issued for veterinary attention, she said she understands.
