Upon my arrival at 15:50, I was checked and signed in and then immediately taken to the AVI room. There were a total of 15 crates making up 3 shipments. 10 of the crates were boxes containing day old chicks. At first, these boxes were placed on the floor, but I made the guy place them on the bird shelving for more adequate ventilation. I also educated the guy on packing crates further away from each other to allow for more adequate ventilation. I took photos of each waybill and each crate. My inspection was concluded at 15:50.
